# **APPLICANTS:**

# AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe City, Placer County.

## **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing joint use pier and two mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 1999.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

## SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

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#### Other:

This lease is conditioned on Lessee's obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years from the effective date of the authorization of the buoys by the Commission.

ONE ADDITIONAL MOORING BUOY: Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(3).
