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#### LEASE RENEWAL

#### APPLICANT:

Emerald Bay Community Association 600 Emerald Bay Laguna Beach, California 92651

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Pacific Ocean, Gulf of Santa Catalina, Laguna Beach, Orange County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of seven buoys and three swimmer safety lines.

#### PREVIOUS LEASE TERM(S):

Ten years, beginning March 30, 1989.

#### PROPOSED LEASE TERM:

Ten Years, beginning March 30, 1999.

#### CONSIDERATION:

\$515 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.


#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of \$1,000,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. The Commission has been issuing leases to the Applicant since 1969 for one buoy and a swimmer safety line. Sometime since the issuance of the most recent lease that expired March 29, 1999, the Association installed

an additional six buoys and two swimmer safety lines. Two of the seven buoys are marker buoys located 150 feet seaward of the swim area to warn approaching watercraft of the swim area. Three of the remaining buoys have attached swimmer safety lines. The additional swim lines were needed as a safety measure given the length of the beach and swim distance to a single, central line. The buoys are installed on an annual basis from May 1 to October 1.

California Coastal Commission staff determined that the annual placement of the seven buoys and three swimmer safety lines does not require a coastal development permit.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.


