GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

LESSEE:

Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District PO Box 9000, Presidio San Francisco, California 94129

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.746 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Corte Madera Creek, near Greenbrae, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued maintenance of existing rock riprap revetment.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning March 1, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
 - Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a) (2).

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Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
