CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE FULL QUITCLAIM OF OIL AND GAS LEASE NOS. PRC 2725.1 AND PRC 2726.1 (4,250 ACRES EACH, LOCATED OFFSHORE GAVIOTA AND POINT CONCEPTION), SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Oil and Gas Lease Nos. PRC 2725.1 and PRC 2726.1 (lease) each contain 4,250 acres of tide and submerged lands located offshore Gaviota and Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, California.

BACKGROUND:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 2725.1 was issued to Texaco Exploration & Production, Inc. (Texaco) on May 4, 1961. Platform Herman was installed on Lease PRC 2725 in 1964 as a satellite production platform serving as a separation and testing facility for 20 subsea wells which were drilled and completed on the lease. The 20 subsea wells were abandoned from 1982 to 1983 and Platform Herman was removed in July 1988. Oil and Gas Lease PRC 2726.1 was issued to Atlantic Richfield Company (25 percent), Mobil Oil Corporation (25 percent), Getty Oil Company (25 percent) and Marathon Oil Company (25 percent) on May 4, 1961. PRC 2726.1 had four exploratory wells drilled into it which were abandoned without completion. Lease PRC 2726.1 was never developed. Through a series of assignments, Texaco gained a 100 percent interest in PRC 2726.1 and is the lessee of record of both leases.

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Peripheral debris was removed last year by the lessee as part of the Commission's seafloor debris removal project.

Public Resources Code section 6804.1 and Lease paragraph 5 permit the lessee to make a written quitclaim at any time of all rights under the lease or of any portion of the leased lands. The quitclaim will be effective when it is filed with the State subject to acceptance by the Commission.

On April 22, 1999, the Commission's Long Beach office staff received the documents "(Full) Quitclaim Deed for State Oil and Gas Lease." The documents are dated April 20, 1999, for Lease No. PRC 2725.1, and April 21, 1999, for Lease No. PRC 2726.1, and quitclaims back to the State <u>all</u> of the lessee's right, title and interest in the leased lands described in Exhibit A of Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 2725.1, and Exhibit A of Oil and Gas lease No. PRC 2726.1. Both leases are dated May 4, 1961.

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the Lease, that the lessee has complied with all applicable laws and Lease provisions and has paid all rentals.


