CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 3499.1 (1,340 ACRES OFFSHORE POINT CONCEPTION), SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 3499.1 contains 1,340 acres offshore Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, California.

BACKGROUND:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 3499.1 (Lease) was issued to Phillips Petroleum Company and Pan Petroleum Company (currently BP Amoco) on July 15, 1966. The Commission accepted Phillips Petroleum Company's assignment of its 50 percent interest in PRC 3499.1 to Exxon Corporation on September 23, 1987. BP Amoco now has a 50 percent interest, and Exxon Corporation has a 50 percent interest and is the current operator of record of PRC 3499.1. Under the terms of the Lease, the lessee is required to pay an annual rental of \$1.00 per acre (\$1,340 for 1,340 acres) and commence drilling operations on the leased lands within three years. In 1967, one well was drilled on the lease and abandoned. No production was established.

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On July 22, 1999, the Commission's Long Beach office received a copy of the document "Release of Oil and Gas Lease" originally executed and dated December 12, 1991, which quitclaims back to the State all of the lessee's right, title and interest in the leased lands described in Exhibit A of Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 3499.1 dated June 15, 1966. The original filing was not accepted because of oil field operations' debris on the Lease. The debris has been removed and Exxon has resubmitted its request.

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the Lease, that the lessee has complied with all applicable laws and Lease provisions and has paid all rentals (no royalty is due as the leased lands were not developed).

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BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 3 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,279,560 WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND 4 SEAWARD THEREFROM 3 STATUTE MILES (SAID GRID LINE BEING THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF P.R.C. 2207); THENCE SOUTH ALONG SAID NORTH-SOUTH GRID 5 LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH AN ENVELOPE LINE EVERY POINT WHICH IS AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE NEAREST POINT ON THE 6 LINE OF ORDINARY LOW WATER OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL OR AT A DISTANCE OF 3 GEOGRAPHICAL MILES FROM THE PRESENTLY EXISTING OUTER-7 MOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS IF ANY WITHIN OR IN THE VICINITY OF THE LEASEHOLD AREA, WHICHEVER SHALL BE FURTHER SEAWARD; THENCE WESTERLY 8 ALONG SAID ENVELOPE LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALI-FORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,255,500 (SAID 9 GRID LINE IS THE SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF P.R.C. 2879); THENCE NORTH ALONG SAID GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION 10 WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND SEAWARD THEREFROM 3 NAUTICAL MILES (SAID LINE 11 BEING THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2879); THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID 12 LEASE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A NORTH-SOUTH CALIFORNIA ZONE 5 GRID LINE HAVING AN "X" COORDINATE OF 1,269,000; THENCE NORTH ALONG SAID 13 NORTH-SOUTH GRID LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH A LINE PARALLEL TO THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL AND SEA-14 WARD THEREFROM 3 STATUTE MILES (SAID LINE BEING THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2207); THENCE EASTERLY ALONG 15 THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY LINE OF SAID LEASE TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; CONTAINING 1,340 ACRES MORE OR LESS. 16

FOR PURPOSES OF THIS DESCRIPTION THE TERMS "LINE OF ORDINARY LOW 17 WATER" AND "GEOGRAPHICAL MILES" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS SAID TERMS HAVE AS USED IN THE SUBMERGED LANDS ACT OF 1953 (67 STAT. 29), 18 AND THE TERM "OUTERMOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS" SHALL MEAN THE OUTER-MOST PERMANENT HARBOUR WORKS WHICH ARE REGARDED AS FORMING A PART OF 19 THE COAST WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 8 ON THE CONVENTION OF THE TERRITORIAL SEA AND THE CONTIGUOUS ZONE ADOPTED APRIL 27, 1958 (U.N. 20 DOC. A/CONF. 13/L.52).

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
