GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL AND PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE

APPLICANTS:

William, Howard and Diane B. Howard 6622 Benham Way Sacramento, California 95831

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 18 foot by 34 foot single-berth floating dock with gangway and rock riprap along the shoreline of the property.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 23, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

Recreational Pier - no monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5; Bank Protection - the public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability Insurance:

Combined single limit coverage of no less than \$500,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


