ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE

LESSEE/ASSIGNOR:

Wickland Oil Company, a California Corporation P.O. Box 13648 Sacramento, California 95853

ASSIGNEE:

C. S. Land, Inc.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

35 acres, more or less, of filled and unfilled sovereign lands in San Pablo Bay near Selby, Contra Costa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Retention of the existing fill for the future development of a water-related industrial use.

CONSIDERATION:

\$10,000 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Lease No. PRC 5736.1 was issued to Wickland Oil Company for the retention of the existing fill which is the result of the deposit of slag from the previous mineral refinery activity at the site. The lease was entered into January 1, 1981, and will expire December 31, 2005. The site had previously been leased to American Smelting and Refining CompanyAGE (ASARCO).

The slag deposits were determined to contain hazardous amounts of heavy metals, and as the result of litigation, Wickland, ASARCO and State Lands entered into an Agreement for Entry of Consent Judgement, dated January 16, 1989. The Agreement laid the foundation for remediation of the site. The site has been capped with an asphalt layer and a water retention system has been installed. The site, for remediation purposes, is under the jurisdiction of the State Department of Toxic Substances Control.

The request for approval of the assignment is for the leasehold only. Wickland will not be released through this action from any continuing responsibility for ongoing remediation.

- 3. Wickland Oil Company, a California Corporation has requested approval of an assignment of General Lease Industrial Use Lease No. PRC 5736.1 to C. S. Land, Inc., a California Corporation.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370, et seq. But will not affect those significant lands.
- 5. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
