## AMENDMENT OF GENERAL LEASE NON-COMMERCIAL USE

### LESSEE:

Edwin Newman 10331 Lindley Avenue, #113 Northridge, CA 91326

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.23 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Pacific Ocean, near the town of Mendocino, Mendocino County.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Temporary placement of an engineering device and a marker buoy.

### LEASE TERM:

Two years, beginning September 1, 1999.

### CONSIDERATION:

\$50 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental periodically during the lease term.

### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Bond:

\$ 10,000

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On September 3, 1999, the Commission approved the temporary placement of an engineering device and a marker buoy for a term of one year beginning September 1, 1999. However, the device and buoy were not installed due to unfavorable weather conditions. Lessee wishes to place the devise and buoy during the summer of 2000 and has requested the Commission extend the lease term for an additional year. The project description remains unchanged.

- 2. A provision has also been added to section 2 of the lease requiring lessee to provide a minimum 10-day advance notice to the California State Lands Commission prior to the installation of the device.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 6, Information Collection; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(5).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


