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RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Marc P. Desautels and Maureen M. Desautels 10 Quail Meadows Drive Woodside, CA 94062

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Kings Beach, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Relocation and retention of four existing mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning February 1, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Applicants are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 2. The applicants own three separate contiguous littoral parcels on which the residence is situated. On November 14, 2001, Tahoe Regional Planning Agency approved four mooring buoys. Permit # 20010795 permitted two buoys in association with Parcel 090-324-04 and two buoys in association with Parcel 090-240-02. Any non-permitted buoys are to be removed.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. CO6 (CONT'D)

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(3).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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


