Ronald E. Muller, as trustee of the GM Family Revocable Trust, dated January 13, 2001 5601 Garden Highway Sacramento, California 95837

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged land, near the Garden Highway, in the Sacramento River, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 6 foot by 32 foot floating dock, and a 2 foot by 14 foot pier and ramp.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On December 17, 1992, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Ronald E. Muller and Jack L. Grayson. That lease expired on November 30, 2000. Ronald E. Muller is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and use the upland, for a single-family dwelling.


