DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Obexer and Son, Inc. P.O. Box 186 Homewood, CA 96141

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Homewood, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredging of the harbor and entrance of Obexer's Marina as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

One year, beginning April 1, 2002

CONSIDERATION:

The public health and safety; a royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any dredged materials used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The purpose of the project is to remove excess materials that have accumulated in the harbor and entrance of the marina, which will impair navigational safety during the upcoming boating season. A maximum volume of 3,000 cubic yards is proposed to be excavated to elevation 6215 feet, Lake Tahoe Datum, in order to maintain a navigable depth. However, only 1,200 cubic yards of that volume are within the Commission's jurisdiction. The Commission has approved prior maintenance dredging of the marina to elevation 6215.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of

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the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (d)(4).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
