RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Jeffrey A. Omand and Diane Deary Omand Trustees of the Diane Deary Omand and Jeffrey A. Omand Family Revocable Trust, dated 7/21/92.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction, use, and maintenance of a gangway, a single-berth floating dock, and piles.

LEASE TERM:

4

Ten years, beginning October 20, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. The proposed project involves the construction of a 3 foot by 60 foot gangway, and a 50 foot by 24 foot single-berth floating dock attached to four pilings.

3.
