## **ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE**

### LESSEE/ASSIGNOR:

Chevron U.S.A., Inc. 4900 California Avenue, Tower B Bakersfield, California 93309

## **ASSIGNEE:**

ConocoPhillips Company 1232 Park Street, Suite 300 Paso Robles, California 93446

## AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

A 352 square foot parcel of sovereign land in Pacheco Slough, near the city of Martinez, Contra Costa County.

## **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Existing 8" pipeline to transport refined petroleum products.

### LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning September 20, 1995.

#### CONSIDERATION:

\$100 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Assignee has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.

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- 2. On June 30, 2000, Chevron sold to Tosco Corporation the pipeline assets known as The Tosco Richmond Products Pipeline. On September 17, 2001, Tosco Corporation became a wholly owned subsidiary of Phillips Petroleum Company and on December 31, 2002, Phillips Petroleum Company changed its name to ConocoPhillips Company, also on the same day Conoco Inc. was merged into newly renamed ConocoPhillips Company.
- 3. The assignment document will not release Chevron from its obligations and responsibilities for performance under the covenants and conditions of the lease.
- 4. The lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that rent be continued at \$100 per year effective September 20, 2001.
- 5. As to the assignment and rent review, pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.


