**TERMINATION OF GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE
AND ISSUANCE OF NEW RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE**

LESSEE:

Barbie J. Barrett, M.D., INC., Money Purchase Pension Plan and Trust Agreement

APPLICANT:

Stuart Corvin

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift and one mooring buoy as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning January 1, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on Applicant's obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoy within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On December 16, 1998, the Commission authorized a General Lease - Recreational Use to Barbie J. Barrett, M.D., INC., Money Purchase Pension Plan and Trust Agreement, the Lessee, for an existing pier, boat lift and one mooring buoy. That lease will expire on January 29, 2008. A change of ownership occurred between the Lessee and Stuart Corvin, the Applicant, who is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

2. **Termination of Existing Lease:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, sections 15060 (c)(3) and 15378.

3. **Issuance of New Lease:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

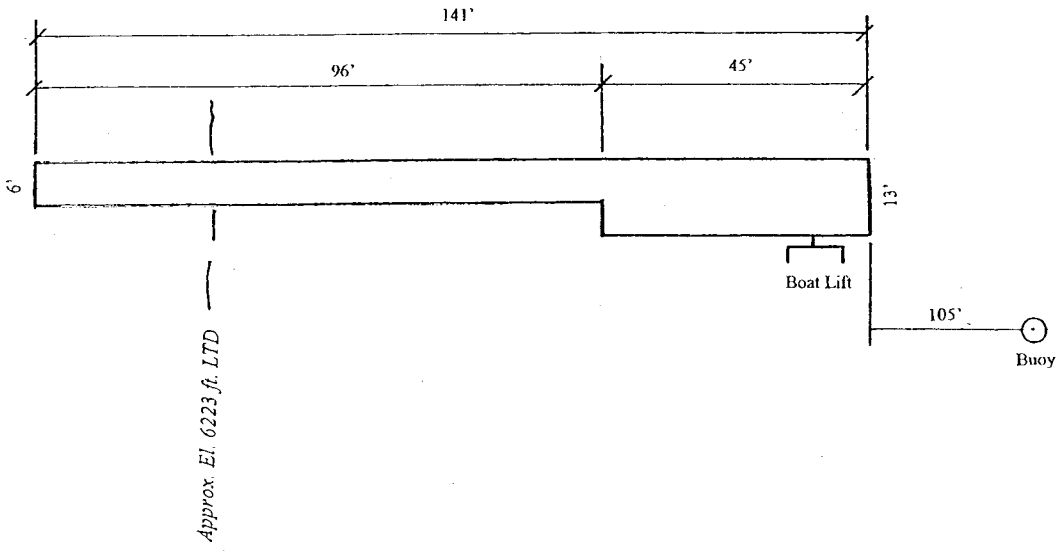

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO STUART CORVIN, OF A TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE, BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2004, FOR THE CONTINUED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING PIER, BOAT LIFT AND ONE MOORING BUOY ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH COVERAGE OF NO LESS THAN \$300,000.

SITE MAP

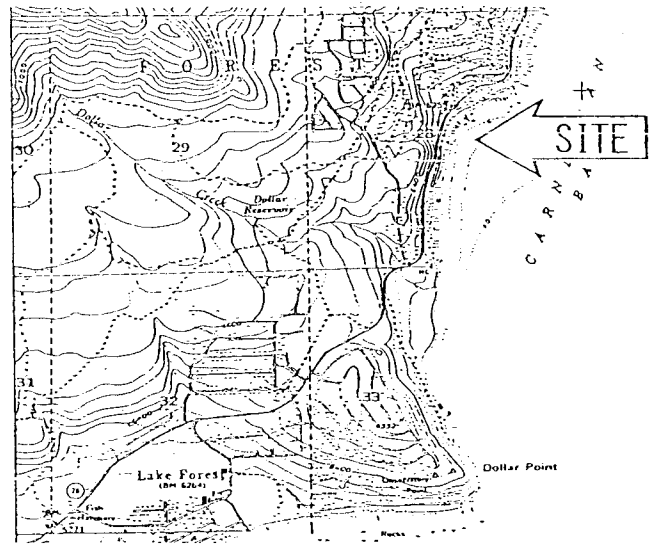


Lake Tahoe

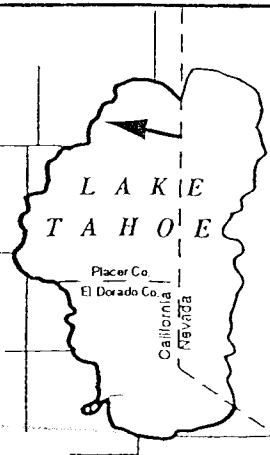
LOCATION MAP
