RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Donald J. Glidewell and Anita K. Glidewell

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway (APN: 201-0260-013), near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock and walkway.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning February 13, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- On April 6, 1994, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Louis and Marian Halasz. That lease has expired. The upland property was transferred to Anita K. Glidewell and subsequently transferred to Donald J. Glidewell and Anita K. Glidewell. Donald J. Glidewell and Anita K. Glidewell for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicants qualify for a rent-free lease for the floating boat dock and walkway because the applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for a single-family dwelling.

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3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
