Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Homewood, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The retention of two existing mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 2005

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on the Applicants obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:


1. Applicants own the upland property adjoining the lease premises.

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2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Applicants are now applying for a new lease for the

retention of two existing mooring buoys, not previously authorized by the Commission.

3. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(3).
