Sovereign lands in Tomales Bay, near Inverness, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, two walkways, and a boathouse.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 8, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On November 15, 1994, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Dorcas B. Roth. That lease has expired and Susan H. York, as successor trustee, is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling. The boathouse is used for boat storage and for the storage of related recreational equipment.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of

the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1. Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

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
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
