DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Marin County Department of Public Works P.O. Box 4186 San Rafael, CA 94913

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay, at the Paradise Cay development, county of Marin.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge for a maximum of 20,000 cubic yards of material over 10 years to maintain a navigable depth in the entrance channel. Dredged materials will be disposed at United States Army Corps of Engineers' designated disposal site SF-11 (Alcatraz). Dredged material may not be sold.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 8, 2005

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged. The dredge material will not be sold. The Project will result in a public benefit to navigation.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. This project is part of a larger dredging project, (195,000 cubic yards over ten years). No lease is required from the Commission for the dredging of 175,000 cubic yards of material that will occur on land that is outside of State sovereign leasing jurisdiction.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from

the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g). Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
