The current project involves the construction of the North Water Street Floodwall to replace the existing retaining wall that has failed and presents a hazard to public safety. In addition, the current project involves the construction of a new road adjacent to the proposed floodwall, the river walk on the east side of the road immediately adjacent to the proposed wall and a sidewalk on the west side of the road.
