REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Darlene A. Brock (Sole Trustee of the Trust of William L. and Darlene A. Brock)

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.05 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating boat dock and walkway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 5, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$260 per year to \$312 per year, effective August 5, 2006. Lessee does not qualify for a rent-free lease for the boat dock and walk way, because the upland is not improved with a single family dwelling (Public Resources Code section 6503.5).

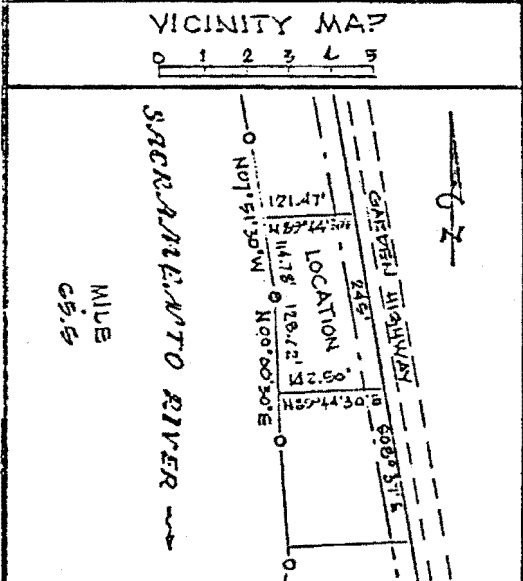
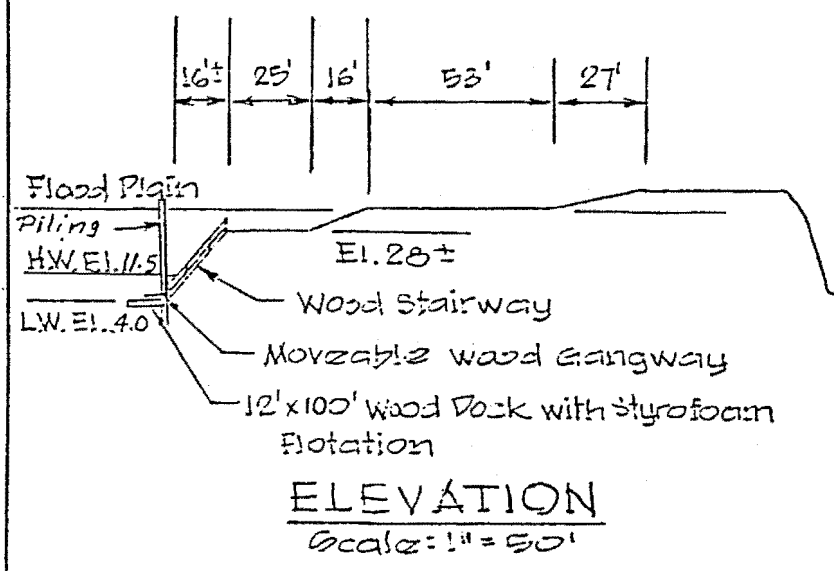
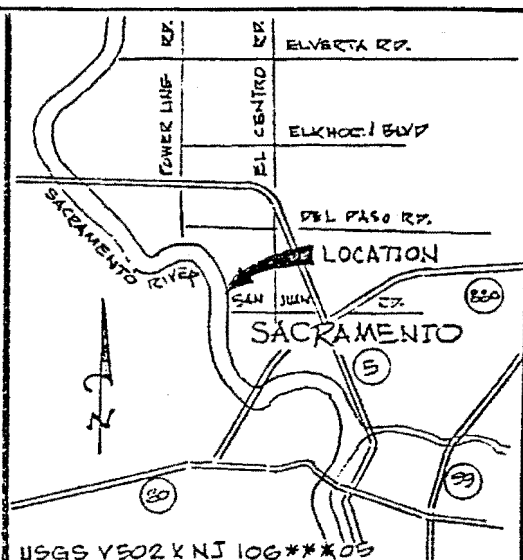
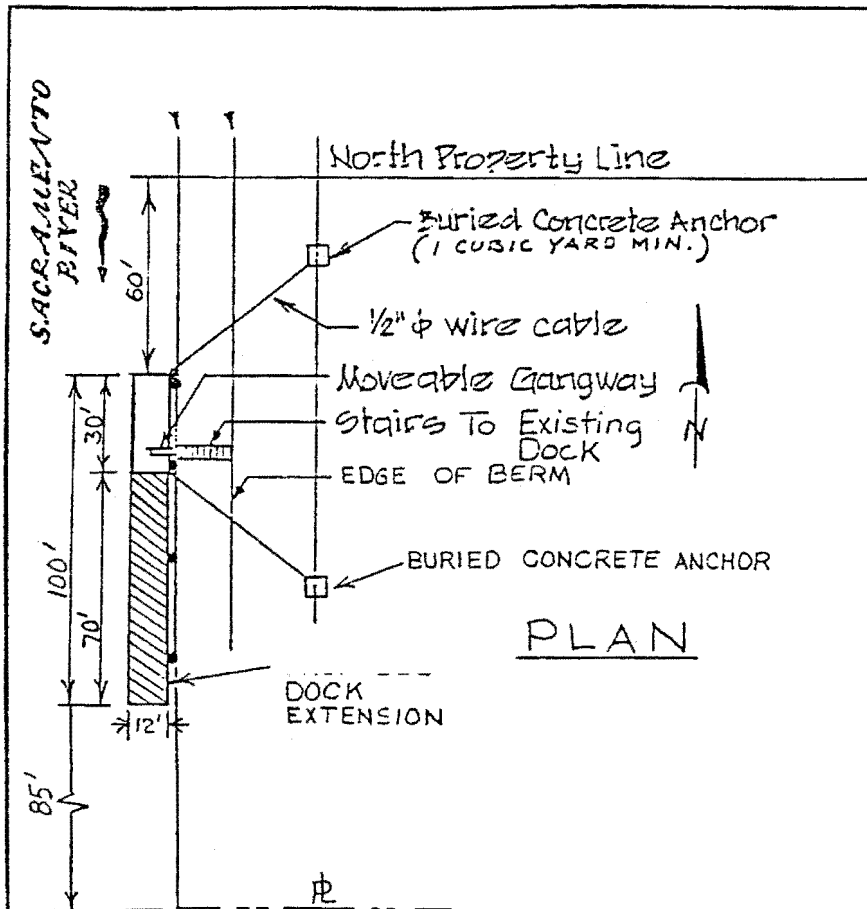
