RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Anna J. Garibotti and Lynne M. Garibotti Blower, Co-Trustees of the Anna J. Garibotti Revocable Trust UDT dated September 30, 1998

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and boathouse with a boat hoist as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 26, 2006

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- On February 27, 1998, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease to Anna J. Garibotti. That lease will expire on August 25, 2006. The upland property has been transferred to Anna J. Garibotti and Lynne M. Garibotti Blower, co-trustees of the Anna J. Garibotti Revocable Trust UDT dated September 30, 1998. The Applicants have now submitted an application for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

- 3. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

5. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
