RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Terence Robert Bunton and Pauline Elizabeth Bunton, Trustees of the Terence and Pauline Bunton Revocable Trust dated September 11, 2001

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Petaluma River, Black Point, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and repair of a float as shown on Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 12, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises and have applied for a Recreational Pier Lease. Applicants qualify for a Rereational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
- 2. On February 12, 1997, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease to the Applicants for a pier and float. During the winter storms of 2006, the previously approved float was damaged. Applicants propose to repair the float and expect that repairs will be completed before October

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31, 2007. The repairs will only be to the float structure. The float will not be reconfigured and no pilings will be moved.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15301 (d).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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





