GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

City of Santa Cruz

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Pacific Ocean, near the city of Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of rock revetment for beach erosion control as shown on Exhibit A .

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 26, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the State finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant has the right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On August 20, 1990, the Commission authorized a General Lease Public Agency Use with the city of Santa Cruz for the placement and maintenance of the rock revetment at various locations which is used for beach erosion control. That lease expired on August 7, 2000. Applicant is now appying for a new General Lease Public Agency Use.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under
