AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Kings Beach, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier with two boatlifts, and two mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:

\$1,115 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$500,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on the Assignee obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Assignee owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On December 8, 2005, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational Use with Alexander Court, L.L.C., A Ltd. Liability Company. That Lease will expire on November 30, 2015. Subsequently, the Lessee transferred an undivided two-thirds interest in the littorial property to Alexander Court, L.L.C., A Delaware Limited Liability Company and an undivided one-third interest in the littorial property to Robert J. Whalen and Kirsten J. Whalen, Trustees of The Robert J. Whalen and Kirsten J. Whalen Family Trust dated February 10, 1987. This assignment of the lease was approved by the Commission on February 9, 2006.
- 3. On May 4, 2006, Alexander Court, L.L.C., A Delaware Limited Liability Company, transferred it's undivided two-thirds interest in the littorial property to Paula Turtletaub, Trustee U/T/A dtd. June 13, 2001, who is now applying for an assignment of the lease effective May 4, 2006.
- 4. Assignee does not qualify for a rent-free lease pursuant to Public Resources Code 6503.5 because the adjacent littorial property is not improved with a single family dwelling.
- 5. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15060(c)(3)], the staff has determined that this activity is not subject to the provisions of the CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

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
