### AMENDMENT OF DREDGING LEASE

### APPLICANT/LESSEE:

Chevron USA, Inc., Richmond Refinery 841 Chevron Way Richmond, CA 94801

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay at the Chevron Richmond Long Wharf, Contra Costa County.

# **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Dredge a maximum of 350,000 cubic yards of material annually over five years, five months, to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged materials will be disposed of at United States Army Corps of Engineers' designated disposal site SF-11 (Alcatraz) and/or Hamilton Army Air Base wetland renewal project, and/or other Dredged Material Management Office approved sites authorized by all applicable state and federal regulatory agencies, including upland reuse areas. Dredged material may not be sold.

#### LEASE TERM:

Five years, five months, beginning June 7, 2004.

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

To maintain a navigable depth, expand the dredging footprint at Berth 4 as shown on the attached Exhibit A and by this reference made a part hereof.

### CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged as the Project will result in a public benefit.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On June 7, 2004, the Commission authorized a dredging lease to the Lessee to dredge material at the Chevron Richmond Long Wharf.

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# CALENDAR ITEM NO. C43 (CONT'D)

Applicant has submitted an application to expand the dredging footprint at the entrance to Berth 4 due to the increased sedimentation of the area. The expanded footprint will reduce a potential danger to navigation, and avoid light-loading and lightering – the process of ship to ship transfer of oil cargo.

2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15304(g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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


