The public health and safety; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.


### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applicant is permittee of the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- On August 26, 1976, the Commission authorized a 25-year General Lease – Public Agency Use to Wetherbee Lake Reclamation District 2096. That lease subsequently expired. The Wetherbee Lake Reclamation District 2096 is now applying for a new lease.

The County of San Joaquin adopted a resolution on August 26, 1975, designating portions of Walthall slough as a slow area for boating.
