REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Southern California Edison Company
2244 Walnut Grove Avenue
Rosemead, CA 91770

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

24.20 acres, more or less, of State school land in a portion of Section 36,
Township 12 North, Range 20 East, SBM, near Homer, San Bernardino County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 500 kV overhead transmission
line.

LEASE TERM:

49 years, beginning August 28, 1968.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease
term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under
this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$455 per year to \$545
per year, effective August 28, 2009.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$2,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On August 28, 1968, the Commission authorized a General Lease - Right
of Way Easement with Southern California Edison Company. That lease
will expire August 27, 2017.

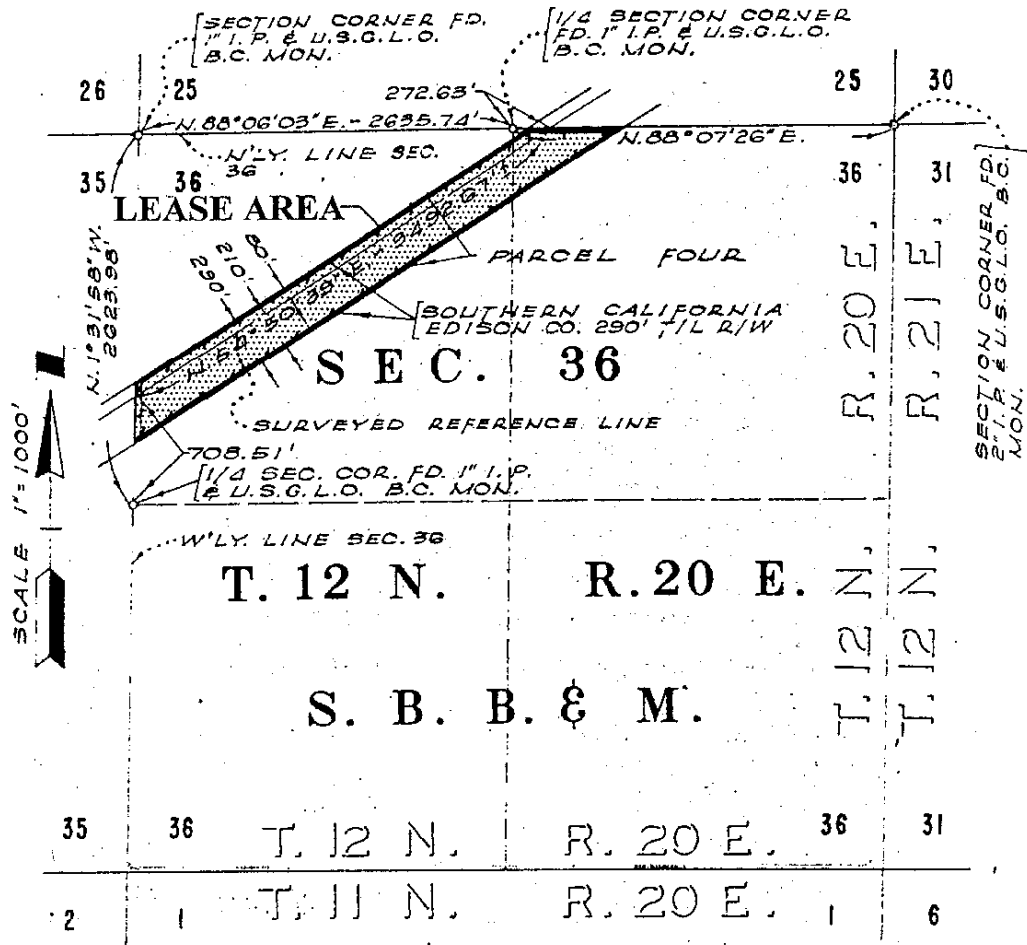

LOCATION

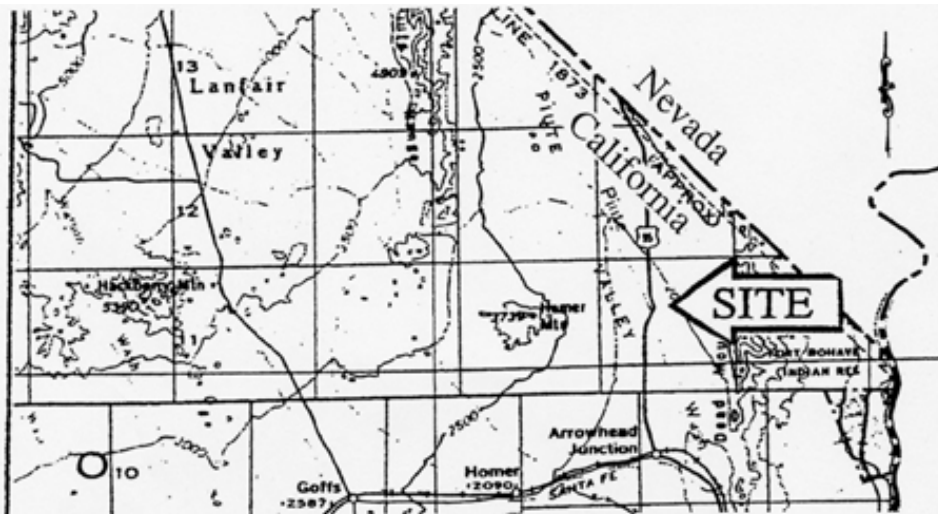
