GENERAL LEASE - DREDGING

APPLICANT:

Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company 150 Solano Way Martinez, California 94553

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Ungranted sovereign land in Carquinez Strait at the Tesoro Golden Eagle Refinery Avon wharf, Suisun Bay, near the city of Martinez, Contra Costa County

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 25,000 cubic yards of material over the term of the lease at the Tesoro Golden Eagle Refinery Avon wharf to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged material to be disposed of at Winter Island, and/or other U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' approved disposal sites.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning August 14, 2012.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration is due for the lease because there is no commercial benefit from the project and the dredged material may not be sold.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1, The purpose of the project is to maintain safe, navigable berth and access channel depths for vessels using the Tesoro Golden Eagle Refinery Avon wharf.
- 2. Negotiations between Tesoro and the Commission are ongoing regarding Tesoro's application to lease the Avon wharf (PRC No. 3454); currently, the lease is in holdover. This dredging lease would be for the purpose of allowing safe navigation at the Avon wharf to continue, pending the completion of negotiations between Tesoro and the Commission concerning the leasing of Avon wharf.

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land; California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15304, subdivision (g).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15300.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq., but such activity will not affect those significant lands. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize the issuance of a General Lease – Dredging to the Tesoro Refining and Marketing Company, for a term of 10 years, beginning August 14, 2012, to maintenance dredge a maximum of 25,000 cubic yards of material during the lease term at the Avon wharf to maintain a navigable depth. Dredged material will be disposed of at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' designated disposal site Winter Island, and/or other U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' approved disposal sites. Such permitted activity is contingent upon the Applicant's compliance with applicable permits, recommendations, or limitations issued by federal, State, and local governments. No monetary consideration is due for the lease because there is no commercial benefit from the project and the dredged material may not be sold.
