REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Southern California Edison Company 2131 Walnut Grove Avenue GO3, 2nd Floor Government Lands Rosemead, CA 91770

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

1.066 acres, more or less, of sovereign land located in the Kern River, northeast of Bakersfield, Kern County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of a 220 kilovolt (kV) overhead transmission line.

LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning February 15, 2009.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$2,878 per year to \$3,134 per year, effective February 15, 2014.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

- 1. On April 9, 2009, the Commission authorized a twenty-five year General Lease Right-of-Way Use with Southern California Edison for the continued use and maintenance of a 220 kV overhead transmission line; the lease commenced on February 15, 2009.
- 2. The staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject revision of rent does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and

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is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
