GENERAL LEASE – RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANTS:

Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima, as Trustees of the Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima 2003 Trust

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land located in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 6508 Benham Way, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing uncovered floating boat dock, gangway and two cables attached to two "deadmen" on the upland.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning October 1, 2014.

CONSIDERATION:

\$125 per year, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On October 6, 2004, the Commission authorized a 10-year Recreational Pier Lease with Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima, as Trustees of the Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima 2003 Trust. That lease expired on September 30, 2014. The Applicants are now applying for a General Lease – Recreational Use.
- 3. The staff recommends that the Commission find that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1,

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15300 and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905.

SIGNIFICANT LANDS INVENTORY FINDING:

Find that this activity is consistent with the use classification designated by the Commission for the land pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use to Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima, as Trustees of the Phillip Hiroshima and Jean Hiroshima 2003 Trust beginning October 1, 2014, for a term of 10 years, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing uncovered floating boat dock, gangway, and two cables attached to two "deadmen" on the upland, as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B (for reference purposes only) attached and by this reference made a part hereof; annual rent in the amount of \$125, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment; and liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of the left bank of said river.
