REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Bruce C. Cline and Julie D. Cline, Co-Trustees of The Cline Family Trust Dated April 11, 2012

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 17360 Grand Island Road, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing L-shaped uncovered floating boat dock, three steel pilings, a gangway, and bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning May 1, 2012.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that the Commission may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff reviewed the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$96 per year to \$125 per year effective May 1, 2018.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On April 26, 2013, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational and Protective Structure Use to Bruce C. Cline and Julie D. Cline, Co-Trustees of The Cline Family Trust dated April 11, 2012, for an L-shaped uncovered floating boat dock, three steel pilings, a gangway, and bank protection (<u>Item C28, April 26, 2013</u>). The lease will expire on April 30, 2022.
- 2. This action is consistent with Strategy 2.2 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to ensure timely receipt of revenues and royalties from the use and development of State lands and minerals.
