REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Ronald J. Gray and Susan D. Gray, Trustees of the Ronald J. Gray/Susan D. Gray Trust, Dated May 16, 1993

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 17408 Grand Island Road, at Long Island, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing fishing pier, walkway, and bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning March 23, 2013.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that the Commission may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff reviewed the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$50 per year to \$125 per year, effective March 23, 2018.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- On October 19, 2012, the Commission authorized a General Lease Recreational Use to Ronald J. Gray and Susan D. Gray, Trustees of the Ronald J. Gray/Susan D. Gray Trust, Dated May 16, 1993 (<u>Item C02</u>, <u>October 19, 2012</u>). The lease will expire on March 22, 2023.
- 2. This action is consistent with Strategy 2.2 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to ensure timely receipt of revenues and royalties from the use and development of State lands and minerals.


A. Site and Location Map


