## AMENDMENT OF LEASE AND REVISION OF RENT

#### LESSEE:

Bullseye Farms, A California General Partnership

## AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 4810 West Lake Boulevard, near Homewood, Placer County.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift, and two mooring buoys.

## LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning June 21, 2013.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that the Commission may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff reviewed the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$1,363 per year to \$1,067 per year, effective June 21, 2018.

#### **PROPOSED AMENDMENT:**

Amend the lease to replace the existing Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map, with the attached Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map (for reference purposes only). All other terms and conditions of the lease shall remain in effect without amendment.

## STAFF ANALYSIS AND RECOMMENDATION:

#### Authority:

Public Resources Code sections 6005, 6216, 6301, 6501.1, 6503, and 6503.5; California Code of Regulations, title 2, sections 2000, and 2003.

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## Public Trust and the State's Best Interests Analysis:

On June 21, 2013, the Commission authorized a 10-year General Lease – Recreational Use to Bullseye Farms, A California General Partnership, for an existing pier, boat lift, and two mooring buoys (<u>Item C42, June 21, 2013</u>). That lease will expire on June 20, 2023.

Staff conducted the rent review called for in the lease and recommends the rent be revised from \$1,363 per year to \$1,067 per year based on changes to the lease (impact) area for the pier and application of the current Lake Tahoe Benchmarks. Staff also recommends the lease be amended to reflect the new reduced lease area.

The lease does not alienate the State's fee simple interest or permanently impair public rights. The recommended action will not substantially interfere with the Public Trust needs at this location, at this time, and for the foreseeable term of the lease. For these reasons, staff recommends finding the proposed action is in the best interests of the State.

## **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. This action is consistent with Strategy 2.2 of the Commission's Strategic Plan to ensure timely receipt of revenues and royalties from the use and development of State lands and minerals.
- 2. Amendment of the lease to make an adjustment in the lease area and approving the revision of the rent are not projects as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act because they are administrative actions that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.

## **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Authorize the amendment of Lease No. PRC 4091.1, a General Lease – Recreational Use, effective June 21, 2018, to replace the existing Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map, with the attached Exhibit A, Land Description, and Exhibit B, Site and Location Map (for reference purposes only).
- 2. Approve the revision of rent for Lease No. PRC 4091.1 from \$1,363 per year to \$1,067 per year, effective June 21, 2018.

#### LAND DESCRIPTION

PRC 4091.1

A parcel of submerged land situate in the bed of Lake Tahoe, lying adjacent to Lot 1 fractional Section 1, Township 14 North, Range 16 East, MDM., as shown on Official Government Township Plat approved January 17, 1866, County of Placer, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1 – PIER

All of the lands underlying an existing pier and boatlift lying adjacent to those Parcels as described in Exhibit "A" of that Grant Deed, recorded May 10, 2012 as Document Number 2012-0041660 of Official Records of said County.

TOGETHER WITH any applicable impact area(s).

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion(s) lying landward of elevation 6223 feet LTD on the shoreline of said Lake Tahoe.

PARCELS 2 & 3 – BUOYS

Two (2) circular parcels of land, each being 50 feet in diameter underlying two (2) existing buoys lying adjacent to said parcels.
