1 PROCEEDINGS

2 COMMISSIONER CHIANG: Good morning. This is  
3 John Chiang, and I call this meeting of the State Lands  
4 Commission to order.

5 Mr. Thayer, as this a telephone conference  
6 meeting, will you call the roll of Commissions in  
7 attendance?

8 EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAYER: Yes.

9 Chairman Chiang?

10 COMMISSIONER CHIANG: Aye.

11 EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAYER: Lieutenant Governor  
12 Garamendi?

13 COMMISSIONER GARAMENDI: Here in Sacramento.

14 EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAYER: Commissioner Sheenan?

15 ACTING COMMISSIONER SHEEHAN: Present in  
16 Pasadena.

17 COMMISSIONER CHIANG: The first item of business  
18 will be the adoption of the minutes from the Commission's  
19 last meeting. May I have a motion to adopt the minutes?

20 COMMISSIONER GARAMENDI: So moved.

21 ACTING COMMISSIONER SHEEHAN: I'll second that  
22 motion.

23 COMMISSIONER CHIANG: We have a motion by the  
24 Lieutenant Governor, seconded by Anne Sheehan.

25 Without objection, the minutes are adopted.

1           The next order of business is the Executive  
2 Officer's report. Paul, may we have your report?

3           EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAYER: Certainly. I don't  
4 have anything of great significance to report.

5           I would echo that we should probably try to  
6 follow the practice that the Chair is using, which is to  
7 please speak up and identify yourself whenever you do  
8 speak, because that will help the recorder who's recording  
9 this meeting and who's in the Commission offices in  
10 Sacramento.

11           The other thing I just wanted to point out is our  
12 next meeting is March 25th in Sacramento. Kim is  
13 arranging a room in the state building in one of the  
14 auditoriums, and we'll get you the particulars on that.

15           At the moment, the rough agenda doesn't seem to  
16 show anything of overwhelming controversy. Everything  
17 would otherwise be on consent. But we may do a  
18 presentation, a status report on where the Poseidon  
19 project is now and the review before us and before the  
20 Coastal Commission, as well as perhaps do a background  
21 hearing on the Mothball Fleet to bring some information  
22 about that. But otherwise, all the other items are more  
23 routine.

24           COMMISSIONER CHIANG: Thank you, Paul.

25           The next item of business is the consent

1 calendar. Is there anyone at any meeting location who  
2 wishes to speak on an item on the consent calendar? Did  
3 somebody indicate so?

4           Hearing none, if not, the item will be taken up  
5 for vote. We will now proceed with the vote.

6           EXECUTIVE OFFICER THAYER: This would be on both  
7 items on the consent calendar. So if any Commissioners  
8 wanted a discussion on that, now would be the time to  
9 speak. Otherwise, we can vote for both of them as a  
10 block.

11           ACTING COMMISSIONER SHEEHAN: I'll move approval  
12 of the consent calendar, if there are no comments.

13           COMMISSIONER GARAMENDI: Garamendi seconds.

14           COMMISSIONER CHIANG: Motion by Anne, seconded by  
15 Lieutenant Governor. Without objection, the motion  
16 passes. Okay. This concludes the open meeting. We are  
17 now adjourned into the closed session. May we have the  
18 locations cleared leaving only those authorized to be  
19 present for the closed session.
