

**NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION
TO BUILDING STANDARDS OF THE
CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISSION REGARDING
THE 2019 CALIFORNIA BUILDING CODE
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PART 2
CHAPTER 31F-MARINE OIL TERMINALS AND
CHAPTER 35 – REFERENCED STANDARDS
(SLC-01-18)**

California State Lands Commission (The Commission or CSLC) is providing notice of proposed changes for incorporation into the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, PART 2 that were the subject of written comments from the initial 45-day public comment period that began on May 18, 2018, until 5:00pm on July 3, 2018.
